The weekend long festivities commence on Friday, November 7th from 3 pm to 7 pm, continues on Saturday, November 8th from 10 am to 5 pm, and ending on Sunday, November 9th from 11 am to 3 pm. In addition to a large variety of local artists' handmade ceramics for sale, there will be raffle baskets and 50/50 tickets for purchase, a mug sale featuring the work of Wayne Art Center ceramic students, and a studio equipment Silent Auction and supply sale. As always, live demonstrations from Wayne Art Center instructors, studio tours and information on upcoming ceramic classes and workshops will continue through the weekend.

Doors open early on Saturday, November 8 with a continuation of the ceramic sales. The weekend's events conclude on Sunday, November 9, with the Framers Café offering Cold Brew, Vietnamese Coffee and Coffee Slushies and conducting a Coffee Seminar from 1 to 1:30 pm.

The Wayne Art Center Pottery Sale is an annual fundraiser for the Ceramic Studio. Past year's events have helped with the purchase of new kilns and additional resources that make the Wayne Art Center Ceramic Studio one of the best in the area.
